Duties and Responsibilities:

The Boulder Meeting of Friends established both the Higher Education Fund and the Scholarship Committee to award college undergraduate scholarships. The Committee is responsible for creating criteria for awarding scholarships, soliciting scholarship applications, evaluating applications received, and choosing the recipients.

The Committee consists of five members, four of who are nominated by the Nominating Committee to serve staggered four-year terms. The fifth member is either the Clerk or the Associate Clerk.
